

# School District #71 TOC Salary Questions

## Finding Your Grid Placement

- On page 20 of the Collective Agreement reference the “Teachers’ Salary Grid Effective July 1, 2007” to find your yearly salary.
- The Contract can be found by
  - going to [www.cdta71.org](http://www.cdta71.org)
  - click on the “Document” page heading
  - click on “Collective Agreement” and
  - scroll to page 20 of the pdf to Salary Grid.
- For a daily rate, divide your category and level amount by 189 days which is now the provincially established count of teaching days in a year—*not the 195 used by SD#71 before this contract was ratified.*
- If unsure of your placement on the Grid and you must know for EI purposes, phone 334-5531 to acquire this information from the SD#71 teacher payroll clerk. (She is busy. Please ask only if you must know.)

## The TOC Daily Rate and Transfer to Salary Grid Parameters

The following wording is printed below the salary grid in the Collective Agreement:

- “Effective July 1, 2007, the TOC’s minimum daily rate becomes \$199.62.
- If TOCs work for four days (there is no requirement that the four days are in the same assignment), they are converted to 1/189 of scale on their fourth day of employment, retroactive to the first day. TOCs earn seniority for all of the time paid on scale.
- Three dollars per day are received in lieu of benefits.” (This is pro-rated for part-time days.)
